Section A: General Considerations

Tools & Equipment

High temperature working

It is suggested that, for temperatures above 35°C, the following guidelines are adopted as good working practice:

- 1. Store unmixed materials in a cool environment, avoiding exposure to direct sunlight.
- 2. Keep equipment cool, it is especially important to keep cool those surfaces of the equipment which will come into direct contact with the material itself.
- 3. Try to avoid application during the hottest times of the day, arrange temporary shading as necessary.
- 4. Make sufficient material, plant and labour available to ensure that application is a continuous process.

Application - points of note

STAR operates a policy to encourage the use, where possible, of approved or licensed applicators. This ensures that applications are completed satisfactorily so that the long term performance of the materials is assured.

Section B: Application Instructions

1. Surface Preparation

- Surfaces to be coated should be clean, solid, free from loose materials, oil grease, paints and free from contamination such as oil, grease, loose particles, decayed matter, moss algal growth, laitance, and all traces of mold, release oils and curing compounds. This is best achieved by lightly grit-blasting the surface.
- 1.2 Where moss, algae or similar growths have occurred, treatment with a proprietary biocide should be carried out after the gritblasting process.
- 1.3 Spalled and deeply disintegrated concrete should be removed to sound concrete and repaired with a appropriate concrete repair system.
- 1.4 Concrete substrates should be at least 14 days old, bituminous substrates should be 3 to 6 months old prior to over coating with STARFIX VB-95.

2. Mixing

- 2.2 STARFIX VB-95 needs to be mixed thoroughly by a Paddle mixer before application
- 2.3 The mix should be placed in time after mixing, more material should not be mixed than can be used within pot life.
- 2.4 Dilution with water should not be done.

3. Application

- 3.1. STARFIX VB-95 is compatible with all traded Fabrics or Membranes for In- & External Duct Linings Coat Joints and Edges in order to seal and prevent air loss.
- 3.2. STARFIX VB-95 can be applied by brush, roller, or airless spray machines.
 STARFIX VB-95 Coating may be airless spray applied. Average viscosity range: 70,000 90,000 cps. Corrosion resistant pumps and fittings are suggested. Please contact STAR for suitable Spray Equipment packages.
- 3.3. <u>Step 1</u>: Apply a tack coat at 60 – 70 sq. ft. per gal. (1.0 – 1.5 m2/l).
- 3.4. Step 2: Immediately embed the selected fabric or membrane into the wet coating. Smoothen out the area to avoid wrinkles and overlap seams by at least 5 cm.
- 3.5. Step 3: Immediately apply a finish coat at 0.5 0.7 m2/l. The dry film thickness of this application will vary with the fabric/membrane.

4. Cleaning

1.1. STARFIX VB-95 product should be removed from tools, equipment and mixers with clean water immediately - prior to the initial set. Cured material can only be removed mechanically.
